The Program at a Glance 2017 - 2018

The Treehouse Early Learning Center of Oak Mountain Presbyterian Church (OMPC) is an outreach ministry that serves the surrounding community. Our desire is to provide families with a safe, quality program for their children from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Children must be at least 12 months old as of September 1 and walking to enroll. The cut-off for each age group is also September 1. All classes are based on enrollment. Please see attached form for more information.

PROGRAM CURRICULUM

Our curriculum promotes children's social, emotional, physical, intellectual and spiritual growth through Bible stories, music, crafts, play time, chapel and classroom instruction. All Bible lessons are taught from a reformed perspective, reflecting our beliefs at OMPC. Instruction is given according to age and developmental levels. Each class is under the direction of two teachers, with the exception of our TK class. For the K4 classes, we include elements of preparation for kindergarten, as well as a weekly Spanish class for children in the 3 year old and K4 classes.

Our Transitional Kindergarten (TK) program is designed for children that have completed a K4 program. TK gives the gift of time to children who need another year to develop physically, socially, or academically prior to entering kindergarten. Our TK program has a comprehensive curriculum that will allow children to be more confident as they move to the next level of academic achievement.

TUITION & FEES

Registration fee: \$110 for the 1st child in a family enrolled & \$70 for each sibling enrolled in the same school year. The registration fee is due upon completion of the attached Registration Form in order to enroll your child in the TREEHOUSE.

\$280 per month for 5-day week

\$250 per month for 4-day week

\$220 per month for 3-day week

\$180 per month for 2-day week

\$150 per month for 1-day week

(We offer a 10% discount for siblings on tuition only)

Early Care

(7:50 a.m. – 9:00 a.m.)

\$100 per month for 5-day week
\$ 80 per month for 4-day week
\$ 60 per month for 3-day week
\$ 40 per month for 2-day week
\$ 20 per month for 1-day week
\$ 10 per day for drop-in

Extended Care

(1:00p.m. – 2:40p.m.)

\$120 per month for 4 days a week
\$ 90 per month for 3 days a week
\$ 60 per month for 2 days a week
\$ 30 per month for 1 day a week
\$ 15 per day for drop-in

For Early and Extended care there will be a \$10 registration fee per family. (If using both, only one fee will be charged) For early care drop-in, please call us at least the day before to let us know you would like early care. For extended care drop-in, you may call as late as that day to check availability for your child.

CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS

Treehouse ELC is not equipped for children with moderate to severe special needs. However, we will consider your child with moderate special needs on a case by case basis. We require that your child already be evaluated by a certified therapist and have an IEP. There will be an additional fee added to your monthly tuition for a special needs aide. Please call the office for more information.
